- To be able to locate, identify and explain different types of lifting equipment, accessories and attachments. Examine their basic construction, explain their uses, applications and functions.
- To be able to interpret and extract information from all relevant documentation
- Explain and demonstrate how to complete a thorough examination inspection report
- Environmental considerations will be covered including ground contamination, debris, and cross contamination
