This qualification is aimed at learners who currently work, or want to work in construction, who need a CSCS Labourers Green card.

TRAINING METHODS

All assessment is via a 40 question multiple choice examination (paper-based) lasting one hour.

* Learners will also need to pass the CITB Health, Safety and Environment Test to get the Green card.

Successful completion of this qualification will enable learners to apply for the Construction Skills Certificate Scheme (CSCS) Green Card, which allows access to construction sites in the UK as a non-skilled worker.
