## WHO SHOULD ATTEND

Personnel who work from prefabricated units with a maximum platform height no greater than 2.5m.



## COURSE AIM

How to safely assemble, dismantle and relocate low level access units without risk of personal injury to the delegate or others.



## TRAINING METHODS

Instruction both in theory and practical sessions. Assessment is via a closed book course with a pass mark of 80% in both theory and practical.



## ADDITIONAL INFO

Delegates attending this course should be **18+ years** and be physically and mentally fit to withstand the rigours of training.

No formal qualifications or experience are necessary, but it would be beneficial if delegates had a basic understanding of working at height issues.
