WHO SHOULD ATTEND

This unit is for managers that are responsible for organising planning and managing work in confined spaces. The manager may or may not supervise the actual job. It involves managing the work of others in, or at confined spaces; reviewing legal requirements; ensuring safety compliance; preparing procedures and appropriate documentation; and making suitable arrangements for dealing with emergencies.

- Understand emergency arrangements and rescue plans

Candidates will have normally completed the relevant 6160 confined space entry qualification for the situations they manage and have managerial and safety awareness experience.

This is designed as a Level 4 Management Course, and is predominantly classroom based.
