WHO SHOULD ATTEND

You are required to hold an ADR licence if you are carrying goods that are categorised in the Dangerous goods list, above specified quantities.



COURSE AIM

To obtain an ADR licence you must pass a minimum of Core, either packages or tanker elements and at least one class according to the goods you are carrying.



TRAINING METHODS

A classroom based course with practical elements in First Aid and Fire Awareness, assessed by formal tests.

- Initial ADR with classes 2,3,4,5,6,8&9 for Packages only - 4 days
- Initial ADR with classes 2,3,4,5,6,8&9 for Packages and Tank elements - 5 days
- Initial ADR with one class for packages and or Tank element - 3 days
- Refresher with classes 2,3,4,5,6,8&9 for Packages only - 4 days
